At the meeting of the Lilburn City Council held at 340 Main Street, Lilburn, Georgia.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 6, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, ARTICLE III “LICENSING AND REGULATION” OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LILBURN; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO PROVIDE FOR AND EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LILBURN GEORGIA, HEREBY ORDAIN THAT CHAPTER 6, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, OF ARTICLE III OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LILBURN SHALL BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

Sec. 6-62. – License; application form.

- (i) Applicant must provide proof of compliance with O.C.G.A. § 3-4-27, and a notice of each application to sell distilled spirits by consumption on-premises and/or package stores, for locations that have not been previously approved or which have not been continuously operated during the last 12 months, shall be provided consistent with the notices of regular and special meetings as set forth in Ordinance 2.19. ~~advertised in the official organ once a week for two weeks immediately preceding consideration of the application by the city council. The City Manager or his/her designee shall cause a sign to be placed upon the property of a proposed package store.~~

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance becomes effective upon its adoption.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all regulations or parts of regulations in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby rescinded to the extent of said conflict.
