THE CITY OF LILBURN 2020 MILLAGE RATE**

WHEREAS: The Mayor and Council of the City of Lilburn wish to adopt a Resolution levying a millage rate, which is established for purposes of financing, in whole or in part, the City's expenses for the fiscal year 2020-2021; and

WHEREAS: The Mayor and Council of the City of Lilburn have studied and reviewed the City's existing millage rate of 4.430 mills and have concluded that it is considered in the best interest of the City to keep the millage rate the same.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Lilburn, Georgia, sitting in regular session on July 13, 2020 that the 2020 millage rate is set at **4.430 mills** for tax year 2020.
