Hello Bill,

My name is Seth Brandt. I am Director of Security at Killian Hill Christian School in Lilburn.

Earlier this year I reached out to the Lilburn Police Department about having speed cameras installed in our school zone.

The exit of our school is located in a very dangerous location, due to the speed of the vehicles that travel through our school zone. It is especially dangerous because of how fast vehicles travel as they come around the corner where river and Arcado meet, heading towards Killian.

In 2019, one of our staff members was hit by a vehicle, and the officers we hire continue to tell me how dangerous it is for them to be down there.

After making multiple requests to both Gwinnett and Lilburn to help enforce the speed in the school zone, we feel that the only way to get vehicles to slow down and honor the school zone speed is to have cameras put in, similar to the ones that you had put in at Trickum Middle. We know that it is not realistic for either PD to be able to patrol our school zone.

I am very concerned about the safety of our parents, our staff and the officers who help us with traffic. Would you all consider helping us out by putting in those cameras?
