ORDINANCE TO AMEND CITY OF LILBURN CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 2, ADMINISTRATION, ARTICLE II, CITY COUNCIL, SECTION 2-20, COMPENSATION, TO ADJUST THE COMPENSATION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL MEMBERS TO REFLECT THAT OF SIMILAR POSITIONS IN OTHER GWINNETT COUNTY CITIES, TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LILBURN GEORGIA, HEREBY ORDAIN THAT THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LILBURN SHALL BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 2-20. – Compensation

The mayor shall receive compensation in the amount of ~~\$5,000.00~~ **\$12,000.00** per year. Council members shall each receive ~~\$3,500.00~~ **\$8,400.00** compensation per year. The mayor shall receive an expense allowance of \$75.00 per month. Council members shall receive an expense allowance of \$45.00 per month.
