

Public hearings set for property tax rate

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LILBURN – The public is invited to comment on the 2022 property tax rate prior to the adoption by Lilburn City Council. The property tax rate is proposed to remain the same as the 2021 property tax rate, 4.43 mills.

Hearings are scheduled at the following dates and times at Council Chambers in Lilburn City Hall, 340 Main Street, Lilburn, Georgia:

Wednesday, June 1, 2022, at 10:00 a.m.

Wednesday, June 1, 2022, at 6:00 p.m.

Monday, June 13, 2022, at 6:00 p.m.

City Council is scheduled to adopt the 2022 millage rate at its regularly scheduled meeting on June 13, 2022, at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers at Lilburn City Hall.

The total estimated amount of property tax revenue to be collected is \$2,714,972, or 19% more than the adopted 2021 budget for property tax revenue. This estimate includes changes in the assessed value of properties, pending appeals, and new growth. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$200,000 is approximately \$73.35 and the proposed tax increase for a non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$200,000 is approximately \$78.24.
