Ben,

It was great to meet you all! We are working on the letter from Mayor Crist to GDOT requesting narrower travel lanes (reduce from 12 ft to 11 ft), a wider multi-use path (increase from 10 ft to 12 ft) separated from the travel lanes with a decorative wall/columns, no bicycle lanes, and a wider sidewalk (increase from 5 ft to 8 -10 ft). We look forward to getting a work order from you all to create our design standards for bridges on Lawrenceville Highway. Mike will send standards we've used on streetlights in the past, though this is open for additional dialogue. Attached are renderings of our conceptual ideas for Lawrenceville Highway. Please note that these concepts have not been vetted by the Mayor and Council, Gwinnett DOT, or GDOT. However, the concept is a target for the bridge design.

The City of Lilburn is collaborating with the Office of Program Delivery to upgrade the replacement of the bridge on Lawrenceville Highway over Jackson Creek (PI 0016519). We appreciate the department's commitment to incorporating feedback from municipalities and the public in your final design for these critical capital projects.

Jenny Simpkins, City Manager, and Tad Leithead, Lilburn Community Improvement District Director, are working with Mr. Tony Washington, GDOT Project Manager, to modify the current plans so that the bridge, once replaced, mirrors improvements the City and LCID would like to make to the Lawrenceville Highway corridor. The changes enhance the safety of transit riders and other users as Gwinnett County plans a bus rapid transit route along Lawrenceville Highway. Narrower vehicle travel lanes, a wider sidewalk, a wider multi-use path separated from traffic with an appropriate structure, lighting, and decorative features enhance the experience for all bridge users.

The City understands that these requested changes may prolong the final design phase and subsequent phases of the bridge replacement project. The City also understands the changes will add cost to the project, and the City intends to cover those added costs. We appreciate your consideration of our request for a Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Lilburn and GDOT for the upgraded replacement of the bridge.




Pitts Road Bridge

Cross Section




Roberts Drive Bridge




