AN ORDINANCE BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LILBURN, GEORGIA TO AMEND CHAPTER 30 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LILBURN ENTITLED “MUNICIPAL COURT” SO AS TO ADD A NEW SECTION 30-4 OF THE CHAPTER TO BE ENTITLED “RULES OF MUNICIPAL COURT”; TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the effective administration of the Municipal Court requires flexibility to implement consistent and efficient internal practices; and

WHEREAS, allowing the Municipal Court to develop operating procedures, forms, and other documents supports orderly court operations and promotes clarity for staff, litigants, and the public; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council for the City of Lilburn hereby amend Chapter 30 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Lilburn to add a new Section 30-4 to be entitled “Rules of Municipal Court.”

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Lilburn, Georgia, sitting in regular session on January 12, 2026, that Chapter 30 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Lilburn, Georgia, is hereby amended to add a new Section 30-4 to read as follows:

Section 30-4. Rules for Municipal Court.

With the approval of the city council, the judge shall have full power and authority to make reasonable rules and regulations necessary and proper to secure the efficient and successful administration of the municipal court, and develop operating procedures, forms, and other documents; provided, however, that the city council may adopt in part or in toto the rules and regulations applicable to municipal courts. The rules and regulations made or adopted shall be filed with the city clerk, shall be available for public inspection, and, upon request, a copy shall be furnished to all defendants in municipal court proceedings at least 48 hours prior to said proceedings.
