ORDINANCE # 2018-522

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 6, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, ARTICLE III “LICENSING AND REGULATION” OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LILBURN; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Mayor and City Council of the City of Lilburn, Georgia, hereby ordain that Chapter 6, Alcoholic Beverages, of Article III of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Lilburn shall be amended to delete Section 6-63(o)(2)(4) and substitute in lieu thereof the following:

ARTICLE III. LICENSING AND REGULATION

Section 6-63(o)(2)(4)

A licensed retail dealer of distilled spirits may sell distilled spirits or packaged malt beverages or wines from “drive-thru” or “service” windows, to customers in vehicles provided any such drive-thru window shall be lighted and clearly visible from a street or sidewalk. Any such drive-thru window shall be covered by a canopy or roof structure in compliance with applicable building codes and any City of Lilburn Overlay District regulations.

All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of any such conflict.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon the signature of the Mayor.
