ORDINANCE # 2018-525

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 6, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, ARTICLE III “LICENSING AND REGULATION” OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LILBURN; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

The Mayor and City Council of the City of Lilburn, Georgia, hereby ordain that Chapter 6, Alcoholic Beverages, of Article III of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Lilburn shall be amended to delete Section 6-63(o)(1)(a) and substitute in lieu thereof the following:

ARTICLE III. LICENSING AND REGULATION

Section 6-63(o)(1)(a)

No application for a retail license to sell distilled spirits in the package at retail shall be granted where the person applying for such license and/or members of that person’s family and/or a corporation already hold two interests in a license to sell distilled spirits by the package at retail within the state. No person and/or member of his/her family and/or a corporation shall own, hold or control any interest whatsoever in more than two licenses in the city to engage in the business of selling distilled spirits by the package at retail.

All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of any such conflict.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon the signature of the Mayor.
