All of these common items can be found in our households at any given time and while in use or storage they are safe. However, when it comes time for disposal, these items are considered "Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)." This means that these materials are corrosive, combustible, reactive, or toxic. If disposed of improperly, they can be harmful to Lilburn's waterways.
