

INVITATION TO SERVE AS A POLL WORKER IN THE 2025 CITY OF LILBURN GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

The City of Lilburn will be holding a General Municipal Election on Tuesday, November 4, 2025, for City Council Posts 3 & 4. Whether you have served before or this would be your first time, we'd like to invite you to serve as a poll worker if you're available.

Key details:

- Advanced voting dates are Tuesday, October 14, through Friday, October 31, with Saturday voting on the 18th and the 25th. 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- Election Day: Tuesday, November 4, 2025 — polls open 7 a.m. until 7 p.m. Staff are expected to remain until poll closing procedures are complete.
- Location: Voting will take place at Lilburn City Hall, 340 Main Street, regardless of county polling locations.
- Mandatory training will be provided by the City Clerk under Georgia law before you can serve. This will be scheduled sometime in late September/early October.
- Eligibility requirements include:
 - *Being a U.S. citizen and a resident or employee of Gwinnett County (or neighboring county with approval)*
 - *At least 16 years old, with ability to read, write, and speak English*
 - *No felony convictions within the past 10 years (unless civil rights restored)*
 - *Not a candidate or immediate relative of a candidate on the ballot at your assigned precinct*
 - *Not currently holding public office (other than political party office)*

Compensation for Gwinnett County poll workers varies by role.

If you're interested in working the election on **November 4, 2025**, and/or during the early voting period from **October 14 to October 31**, please email the City Clerk, Anja Peay, [by **September 18**](mailto:anja.peay@lilburnga.gov) with:

1. Your full name
2. Whether you've previously served as a poll worker (and if so, what role)
3. Your contact information (best phone number/email)
4. Any known availability issues or conflicts

We'll follow up with training schedules and assignment details.

Serving as a poll worker is a meaningful way to support our local democracy. This opportunity offers not only compensation but also a chance to learn more about elections, engage with the community, and ensure a smooth voting experience for fellow residents.
